

Daniel - One Memory Verse from Each Chapter (12)

Daniel 1:9	God had caused the official to show favor and sympathy to Daniel.
Daniel 2:28	There is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries.
Daniel 3:28	Praise be to the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who has sent His angel and rescued His servants! They trusted in Him and defied the king's command and were willing to give up their lives rather than serve or worship any god except their own God.
Daniel 4:3	His [God's] kingdom is an eternal kingdom; His dominion endures from generation to generation.
Daniel 5:21	The Most High God is sovereign over the kingdoms of men and sets over them anyone He wishes.
Daniel 6:23	When Daniel was lifted from the den, no wound was found on him, because he had trusted in his God.
Daniel 7:22	The Ancient of Days came and pronounced judgment in favor of the saints of the Most High.
Daniel 8:25	He [God's enemy] will destroy many and take his stand against the Prince of princes. Yet he will be destroyed, but not by human power.
Daniel 9:18	We do not make requests of You because we are righteous, but because of Your great mercy.
Daniel 10:12	Since the first day that you set your mind to gain understanding and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard.
Daniel 11:35	Some of the wise will stumble, so that they may be refined, purified and made spotless until the time of the end.
Daniel 12:1	There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time your people -- everyone whose name is found written in the book -- will be delivered.
