

Isaiah - One Amazing Verse From Each Chapter

Isaiah 1	18	Come now, let us reason together, says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow."
Isaiah 2	22	Stop trusting in man, who has but a breath in his nostrils. Of what account is he?
Isaiah 3	10	Tell the righteous it will be well with them, for they will enjoy the fruit of their deeds.
Isaiah 4	2	In that day the Branch of the LORD will be beautiful and glorious.
Isaiah 5	20	Woe to those who call evil good and good evil.
Isaiah 6	3	Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory.
Isaiah 7	14	The Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call Him Immanuel.
Isaiah 8	10	Devise your strategy, but it will be thwarted; propose your plan, but it will not stand, for God is with us.
Isaiah 9	6	For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
Isaiah 10	3	What will you do on the day of reckoning, when disaster comes from afar? To whom will you run for help?
Isaiah 11	2	The Spirit of the LORD will rest on Him -- the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.
Isaiah 12	3	With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.
Isaiah 13	11	I will put an end to the arrogance of the haughty and will humble the pride of the ruthless.
Isaiah 14	24	Surely, as I have planned, so it will be, and as I have purposed, so it will stand.
Isaiah 15	1	An oracle concerning Moab: Ar in Moab is ruined, destroyed in a night!
Isaiah 16	5	In love a throne will be established; in faithfulness a man will sit on it -- one from the house of David.
Isaiah 17	7	In that day men will look to their Maker and turn their eyes to the Holy One of Israel.
Isaiah 18	7	Gifts will be brought to Mount Zion, the place of the Name of the LORD Almighty.
Isaiah 19	25	The LORD Almighty will bless them, saying, "Blessed be Egypt My people, Assyria My handiwork, and Israel My inheritance."
Isaiah 20	5	Those who trusted in Cush and boasted in Egypt will be afraid and put to shame.
Isaiah 21	17	The LORD, the God of Israel, has spoken.
Isaiah 22	11	You built a reservoir between the two walls for the water of the Old Pool, but you did not look to the One who made it, or have regard for the One who planned it long ago.
Isaiah 23	9	The LORD Almighty planned it, to bring low the pride of all glory and to humble all who are renowned on the earth.
Isaiah 24	6	A curse consumes the earth; its people must bear their guilt.
Isaiah 25	8	The Sovereign LORD will wipe away the tears from all faces; He will remove the disgrace of his people from all the earth.
Isaiah 26	3	You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in You.
Isaiah 27	5	Let them come to Me for refuge; let them make peace with Me.
Isaiah 28	16	See, I lay a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; the one who trusts will never be dismayed.
Isaiah 29	16	Can the pot say of the potter, "He knows nothing"?
Isaiah 30	15	In repentance and rest is your salvation, in quietness and trust is your strength.
Isaiah 31	6	Return to Him you have so greatly revolted against.
Isaiah 32	17	The fruit of righteousness will be peace; the effect of righteousness will be quietness and confidence forever.
Isaiah 33	6	He will be the sure foundation for your times, a rich store of salvation and wisdom and knowledge; the fear of the LORD is the key to this treasure.
Isaiah 34	1	Come near, you nations, and listen; pay attention, you peoples! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it.
Isaiah 35	4	Say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, do not fear; your God will come."

Isaiah 36	5	On whom are you depending?
Isaiah 37	26	Long ago I ordained it. In days of old I planned it; now I have brought it to pass.
Isaiah 38	15	I will walk humbly all my years because of this anguish of my soul.
Isaiah 39	5	Hear the word of the LORD Almighty.
Isaiah 40	28	Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and His understanding no one can fathom.
Isaiah 41	13	I am the LORD, your God, Who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you.
Isaiah 42	8	I am the LORD; that is My name! I will not give My glory to another.
Isaiah 43	19	See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland.
Isaiah 44	22	I have swept away your offenses like a cloud, your sins like the morning mist. Return to Me, for I have redeemed you.
Isaiah 45	22	Turn to me and be saved, all you ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other.
Isaiah 46	4	Even to your old age and gray hairs I am He, I am He who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.
Isaiah 47	10	You have trusted in your wickedness and have said, "No one sees me." Your wisdom and knowledge mislead you when you say to yourself, "I am, and there is none besides me."
Isaiah 48	17	I am the LORD your God, Who teaches you what is best for you, Who directs you in the way you should go.
Isaiah 49	16	See, I have engraved you on the palms of My hands.
Isaiah 50	10	Let him who walks in the dark, who has no light, trust in the name of the LORD and rely on his God.
Isaiah 51	5	My righteousness draws near speedily, My salvation is on the way, and My arm will bring justice to the nations.
Isaiah 52	12	The LORD will go before you, the God of Israel will be your rear guard.
Isaiah 53	5	But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed.
Isaiah 54	10	Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet My unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor My covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD, who has compassion on you.
Isaiah 55	9	As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts.
Isaiah 56	7	My house will be called a house of prayer for all nations.
Isaiah 57	15	I live in a high and holy place, but also with him who is contrite and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly and to revive the heart of the contrite.
Isaiah 58	6	Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke?
Isaiah 59	16	He saw that there was no one, He was appalled that there was no one to intervene; so His own arm worked salvation for Him, and his own righteousness sustained Him.
Isaiah 60	20	The LORD will be your everlasting light, and your days of sorrow will end.
Isaiah 61	10	I delight greatly in the LORD; my soul rejoices in my God. For He has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness.
Isaiah 62	5	As a bridegroom rejoices over his bride, so will your God rejoice over you.
Isaiah 63	7	I will tell of the kindnesses of the LORD, the deeds for which He is to be praised.
Isaiah 64	4	Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides You, Who acts on behalf of those who wait for Him.
Isaiah 65	17	Behold, I will create new heavens and a new earth. The former things will not be remembered, nor will they come to mind.
Isaiah 66	2	This is the one I esteem: he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and trembles at My word.
